A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COST OF PLANNING STUDIES AND PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING COSTS FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CROTON FALLS WATER DISTRICT, IN THE TOWN OF NORTH SALEM, WESTCHESTER COUNTY, NEW YORK, AT A MAXIMUM ESTIMATED COST OF \$250,000, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$250,000 BONDS OF SAID TOWN TO PAY THE COST THEREOF.

WHEREAS, all conditions precedent to the financing of the object or purpose hereinafter described have been performed; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to authorize the financing thereof; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of North Salem, Westchester County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Planning studies and preliminary engineering costs relating to proposed improvements to the Croton Falls Water District, in the Town of North Salem, Westchester County, New York, including incidental expenses related thereto, are hereby authorized at a maximum estimated cost of \$250,000, pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 99-d.

Section 2. The plan for the financing of the aforesaid maximum estimated cost is by the issuance of not exceeding \$250,000 bonds of said Town, hereby authorized to be issued therefor pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 3. It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is five years, pursuant to subdivision 62(2nd) of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law. It is hereby further determined that the maximum maturity of the serial bonds herein authorized **will not exceed five years**.

Section 4. The faith and credit of said Town of North Salem, Westchester County, New York, are hereby irrevocably pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds becoming due and payable in such year. To the extent not paid from other sources, there shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property in said Town, a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due and payable.

Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the Supervisor of said Town, the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said Supervisor, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 6. The powers and duties of advertising such bonds for sale, conducting the sale and awarding the bonds, are hereby delegated to the Supervisor, who shall advertise such bonds for sale, conduct the sale, and award the bonds in such manner as he shall deem best for the interests of said Town, including, but not limited to, the power to sell said bonds to the New York State Environmental Facilities

Corporation; provided, however, that in the exercise of these delegated powers, he shall comply fully with the provisions of the Local Finance Law and any order or rule of the State Comptroller applicable to the sale of municipal bonds. The receipt of the Supervisor shall be a full acquittance to the purchaser of such bonds, who shall not be obliged to see to the application of the purchase money.

Section 7. All other matters except as provided herein relating to the bonds herein authorized including the date, denominations, maturities and interest payment dates, within the limitations prescribed herein and the manner of execution of the same, including the consolidation with other issues, and also the ability to issue bonds with substantially level or declining annual debt service, shall be determined by the Supervisor, the chief fiscal officer of such Town. Such bonds shall contain substantially the recital of validity clause provided for in Section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law, and shall otherwise be in such form and contain such recitals, in addition to those required by Section 51.00 of the Local Finance Law, as the Supervisor shall determine consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 8. The Supervisor is hereby further authorized, at his sole discretion, to execute a project finance and loan agreement, and any other agreements with the New York State Department of Health and Department of Environmental Conservation and/or the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation, including amendments thereto, and including any instruments (or amendments thereto) in the effectuation thereof, in order to effect the financing or refinancing of the specific object or purpose described in Section 1 hereof, or a portion thereof, by a bond, and/or note issue of said Town in the event of the sale of same to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation.

Section 9. The power to issue and sell notes for said class of objects or purposes to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation pursuant to Section 169.00 of the Local Finance Law is hereby delegated to the Supervisor. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents as may be prescribed by said Supervisor consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

!	Section	11. This resolution shall constitute a statement of official intent for purposes
of Treas	sury Re	egulations Section 1.150-2. Other than as specified in this resolution, no monies are, or
are reas	sonably	expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with
respect	to the p	permanent funding of the object or purpose described herein.
!	Section	12. This resolution, which takes effect immediately, shall be published in
summai	ry form	in the official newspaper of said Town for such purpose, together with a notice of the
Town C	Clerk in	substantially the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law.
