PROJECT: North Salem Refuse Contract

Town of North Salem, Westchester County, New York

Refuse questions Addendum #1

Question 1: We are requesting the following information pertaining to the Bid for Collection of Refuse and Recyclable Materials.

1. How many residents are utilizing driveway service and what are the addresses? 110. The Town of North Salem does not have their addresses as that money is billed by the refuse company directly to the individual homeowner.

2. Provide a list of commercial businesses to be serviced under this contract and what are the quantity and size of containers used at these locations and provide addresses. The refuse company supplies 1.5 yard dumpster to each one of the commercial businesses who wants one. It appears 2 yard containers may have been used instead due to the quantity supplied. Four town facilities are also included as well as the NS Ambulance Corp and CFFD. There are about 81 container pickups of commercial garbage and recycling across about 60 locations. We are still going through the list address by address to confirm the accuracy of our list. We show 85 businesses in Town, not 81. Some use larger dumpsters as the picture shows and pay the current contractor directly. Other commercial properties may get dumpsters from other refuse companies as the size we offer is not sufficient for them. Example, school district and nursing homes.

3. What are the hours for the 1x month bulk service? 9AM to 12PM. Who monitors the list of residents who have permission to drop off bulk items on a Saturday? The refuse company does. The resident is told that they need to provide the Sheet Block and Lot number of their residence to get on the list. An ID can also be requested. About one garbage truck per Saturday (month) is sufficient to handle all of the items.
4. Monthly invoicing, does it need to be submitted online? No, it can be via mail or sent to accountspayable@northsalemny.org. Currently all invoices need to be submitted with a Town Voucher.
5. Does the town designate the disposal site, or can hauler dispose material at their chosen location? The disposal needs to follow Westchester and NYS laws. All recycled items need to be recycled.

6. Does the Vendor need to provide bags for the cans located at Croton Falls? Bags are not required. The cans are simply removed from their racks and emptied. These are small cans, about 30-40 gallons.

Question 2: Who owns the current containers are each home?

1. The homeowner owns the regular "refuse/garbage can container." Our current refuse contractor Win Waste owns the recycling containers. Recycling containers (two for dual stream recycling) need to be made available to the residents by the refuse contractor.

Question 3: Yard Waste:

1. An additional request for clarification around the yard waste. In the bid document it refers grass and leaves clipping can be deposited after pickup at the Town Highway Garage – page 24, under Recyclables. On page 27 there is a reference that says during the proper season an estimated tonnage of leaves (aka vegetative yard waste) is also requested for our filings with the County. At the back of the bid document, from the current vendors documents, there is curbside yard waste pickup schedule, and it states the grass and leaves must be placed in biodegradable bags and placed curbside for collection. Can you please provide clarification on what the scope of work is for leaves/grass clippings? **Answer Yard Waste:** Yard waste is picked up by the refuse company around Town for the dates on the schedule. The leaves and grass are dropped off at the highway garage at 250 June Road. The yard waste needs to be in biodegradable (paper) bags, no plastic bags. The Town also picks up leaves on Town Roads that are unbagged and in piles with a vacuum truck. That is not part of this contract. Additional people put leaves out in bags for refuse pickup - not too many. The Town nor its current contractor has the exact tonnage. The Town Highway Department estimates a total of ten 10 yard garbage trucks.
2. Please provide invoices for May, June, October, November 2023, which should reflect the seasonal yard waste pickup. There is not an additional charge for yard waste pickup so the invoices for May, June, October, November 2023, are the same as previous other months.

This First Amendment to the North Salem Refuse and Recyclable Materials Collection Agreement is made and entered into as of April 11, 2019 (the "Effective Date") between City Carting, Inc., a Connecticut Corporation with an office at 8 Viaduct Road, P.O. Box 17250, Stamford, CT 06907 ("Contractor") and the Town of North Salem, a New York municipal corporation with its offices at 266 Titicus Road, North Salem, New York 10560. The Town, and City Carting are sometimes each referred to as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Contractor and the Town entered into a Refuse and Recyclable Materials Collection Agreement, which agreement is dated September 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the parties have deemed it necessary to make certain amendments to said Agreement which are being incorporated into this Amendment No. 1.


NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, and other good and valuable consideration received, the parties agree as follows:

1. Each and every amendment to the original agreement dated September 1, 2018, and set forth in the attached Schedule A shall take effect and be effective as of August 1, 2019.


2. All of the other terms and conditions of the Refuse and Recyclable Materials Collection Agreement dated September 1, 2018, shall remain in full force and effect.

YEAR 2 ADDENDUM SCHEDULE OF PRICE

This contract is being extended for 5 years through August 2024 at a 2% per year increase.

YEAR 2 - September 1, 2019 – August 31, 2020

- Item #1 Monthly lump sum price for all Residential Refuse Pick-up and Disposal. (Maximum 4 cans/household/week).
- 1 Day a week: Amount words ___Forty five thousand_____ \$45,000_ /Month.
- Item #2 Monthly lump sum price for all Commercial Refuse Pick-up and Disposal. (Maximum 4 cans or 1-1/2 CY container per week per lot).
- 1 Day a week: Amount words _Three thousand seven hundred fifty__ \$3,750/Month.
- Item #3 Monthly lump sum price for all Residential and Commercial Recyclable (as defined in Chapter 177 of the North Salem Town Code) Pick-up.
- 1 Day a week: Amount words_ Ten thousand_ \$10,000__ /Month.
- Alternating week pickup of cardboard, paper and fiber material. The following week pickup of metal, plastics and glass. City Carting will provide 32 or 64 gallon totes for recyclable materials at their cost. If there are changes in the broader recycling environment such that it is economically beneficial to go back to single stream recycling, City Carting and North Salem agree to renegotiate that portion of the contract in good faith.
- Item #4 Monthly Bulk Drop-off. One container monthly at a central location. In the current contract the Town maintains a list of residents who have permission to drop off items on a Saturday. Maximum 2 yards per residence. *Note: To date this has been done with one truck that compresses the dropped off items. The truck shows up and leaves the one Saturday/month.*
- Amount words_ One thousand two hundred and seventy six __ \$1,276/ 30 Yd
- Item #5 Town Highway Department
- A. Two (2) 30-yard roll-off containers per month as needed
Amount words _Nine hundred and fifty_____ \$950/Month.
- B. One (1) 30-yard roll-off container for tires per year as needed
Amount words __Nine hundred and fifty____ \$950/Month.
- Item #6 AT-HOUSE pick-up for Residential Refuse and Residential Recyclables. Not to include bulk or eWaste. **Note that the Town is already paying for each residence in item 1. This is the cost in addition to what the Town payment for the residence is in item 1.**
- Amount words ___Sixty five_____ \$65/Month.

1. Contract will start no later than August 2019
2. We will collaborate on the proper communication method to notify everyone which at least one mailing will be paid for by City Carting..
3. The contract will be extended to its maximum allowable 5 year term, August 31, 2024)
4. The agreed to increase is 2% per year, the above prices are for Year 2, the 2019-2020 original contract year.



Garbage and Recycling Collection 2023-2024 for the Town of North Salem

Household Garbage

- Once a week collection (see street listing on the last page) includes food waste and trash which can be put into normal garbage cans not weighing more than 60 lbs. each when full.
- Four (4) 30 gallon pail limit per household.
- Additional services, such as in-driveway, in-garage and rear door pickup are available directly from WIN WASTE. The cost for these additional services is paid 3 months in advance. Please call 914-277-4211 for additional information.
- Household garbage must be out by 6:00 a.m. on scheduled collections days, no more than 4 feet from the curb.
- Paint cans will only be picked up if they are empty or do not contain liquid paint. If you have any questions regarding disposal of paint call WIN WASTE.
- For special pickup of materials such as construction debris or bulky household items not routinely picked up during regular refuse service, call 914-277-4211 to make pick up arrangements. The cost of these additional services are paid directly to WIN WASTE.

Newspapers, Magazines and Commingled Bottles, Cans and Plastics

- Once a week collection (see schedule).
- All goods should be out for pickup by 6:00 a.m.
- All newspapers/magazines/paper/cardboard should be broken down and placed loose in your bin with the **blue lid**; commingled bottles/cans/plastics should also be placed loose in your bin with the **green lid**.

Holiday Trees

- Will be picked up Wednesday, January 10, 2024.

Winter Weather

- Driveways must be free of ice and snow for in-driveway, in-garage and back door pickup.

Reporting Problems

- If you have any problem with your garbage collection, you should first contact WIN WASTE at **914-277-4211** between the hours of 7:00 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. **Residents should advise WIN WASTE that they are under the Town of North Salem Municipal Contract.** Please leave questions or messages on the answering machine at 914-277-4211 and you will be called back on the next business day.

Commercial Garbage Collection

- As part of your property taxes, the Town of North Salem provides once a week collection to all commercial property owners.
- Pickup is limited to either a 1.5 cubic yard container or four pails not weighing more than 60 lbs. each.
- Additional pickups and services are available from WIN WASTE (containers ranging from 2 cubic yards to 10 cubic yards) at an additional cost.
- All commercial garbage must be left behind the building on the scheduled collection days by 6 a.m. (see street listing on the last page).
- For special pickup of materials such as construction and bulky items not routinely picked up during regular refuse service call WIN WASTE at **914-277-4211**.

Curb Side Yard Waste Pick-up

Grass Clippings and leaves will be picked up on Wednesdays on the dates listed below. Grass and leaves must be placed in biodegradable bags and placed curbside by 6:00 a.m. for collection. Bags cannot be larger than 30 gallons and there is a limit of 20 bags per household per month.

BULK DROP-OFF

Bulk drop-off is for resident's household items only on the third Saturday of each month between the hours of 9 a.m. and noon at the Town Highway Department (250 June Road). Each household is limited to two (2) cubic yards. Any bulk in excess of the amount must be paid for directly to WIN WASTE. The following items will NOT be accepted for bulk drop-off:

Construction, renovation or remodeling debris including kitchens, baths, decks and windows will NOT be accepted. Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or any other appliance containing Freon must be discharged and tagged by a State authorized specialist.

North Salem residents are to call WIN WASTE at **914-277-4211** to make an appointment prior to the scheduled drop-off date. Residents MUST supply WIN WASTE with their name, address, sheet, block and lot number prior to the drop-off date. ***Residents should advise WIN WASTE that they are under the Town of North Salem Municipal Contract.***
