**RESOLUTION #132-15
TO DESIGNATE MILLS ROAD
FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH BOGTOWN ROAD WESTWARD
TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH TITICUS RIVER ROAD
AS A HISTORIC ROAD**

Motion made by Supervisor Lucas
Seconded by Councilwoman Rosmarin

RESOLVED, that the proposed action is a Type 2 action under the Environmental Quality Review Act and its implementing regulations (6 NYCRR Part 617) and it is hereby determined that the proposed action will not result in any significant adverse environmental impact; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of North Salem hereby approves the designation of Mills Road from its intersection with Bogtown Road west to its intersection with Titicus River Road as a Historic Road. On the north side of Mills Road, the Mills Road Historic Road designation boundary shall be to the right-of-way. On the south side of Mills Road, the Mills Road Historic Road designation boundary shall be to the right-of-way or to and including the stone walls along the road, whichever is farther; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Historic Road designation does not place restrictions on the NYCDEP that in any way prevent their conducting all operations necessary for water supply purposes; the designation protects the stone walls on the south side of the road but does not require the NYCDEP or anyone else to maintain them; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to record the boundaries of said historic road in accordance with Section 131-5B.
