WHY TREES ARE IMPORTANT **TO OUR COMMUNITY**

- Trees provide shade, impede soil erosion, aid water absorption, and enhance air quality.
- Trees offer a natural barrier to noise, serve as natural habitat for wildlife, promote biodiversity, and ecological connectivity.
- Trees provide color, seasonal variation, vertical relief, and visual continuity across the broader landscape.
- Tree forests help provide a "critical mass" of prime habitat for many types of wildlife and sequester carbon dioxide.
